At Knapp Creek, we feel that is very important for you to establish a working relationship with your veterinarian. Your puppy needs to have a physical exam very soon after you bring he/she home. (This is also required for activating our health warranty.) At this time, you and your veterinarian will be able set up a health care schedule according to their recommendations. It will also make you feel more comfortable asking them questions if you have any concerns about your puppy.

Some things to ask your veterinarian about:

- Vaccinations
- Fecal Exams/Wormings
- Heartworm Prevention
- Flea and Tick Prevention
- Spay/Neuter recommendations
- Teeth brushing
- Feeding/Nutrition (see ours also!)
- Grooming recommendations
- Puppy class recommendations
- Emergency service
